What is an app?

Apps allow you to write and read data

- Spreadsheets allow you to create reports on numerical data that you first write and then read that data as a report
- Social media apps allow you to write posts and read other people's posts
- Video editing apps allow you to create videos by writing video data as clips and reading those clips in an order you specify and export as a full video

- Attendance records
- Community outreach results

Diagram your UX flow

What actions should a person perform in your app to complete their task?

- Tap a button
- Type out text

- Wix (front-facing website)

Questions To Ask Yourself

- Is this idea something my community members will benefit from? Does it solve a problem?
- 2. Is my community interested in new technology? If not, how do I get them on board with my ideas?
- 3. Do they have ideas for apps as well? Be open to suggestions.
