

California Mandated Enhanced background check for Youth Service Organizations

New 2022 California law AB 506 requires **ALL SCC Employees** and **Volunteers** who have direct contact with children under 18 to be Live Scan / fingerprinted and complete Child Abuse Mandated Reporter Training

1. Get Live Scan / fingerprinted.

- Follow Employee Live Scan Request Procedures



2. Do Child Protection Training.

- Must complete every two years

3. Turn in receipt and get reimbursed from employing entity.

- Locally funded employees should contact their local pastor for reimbursement process. Receipt and certificate of completion of child protective training must be provided.
